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THEME	RESEARCH PROJECT 2: THE KINGS AND PROPHETS OF THE DIVIDED KINGDOM

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OVERVIEW

The second research project gives students the opportunity to investigate a prophet and a king from the period that follows on from the division of the nation after Solomon's life. The challenge is to work out how to allocate the Kings and Prophets to students so that you spread them out across the class but keep the amount of work equitable. That is, some prophetic books are a lot longer than others!

OUR TIPS

Hopefully the instructions in the chapter are straight forward about what is required of the students. To help them investigate their responses we would suggest that you:

- Use the information at the start of the prophetic books in study Bibles.
- Have computers available to help them research further.
- Encourage them to first read the accounts in Kings and Chronicles about their king before they start looking on the internet for information about them.
- Think about how you would like to have the information presented. You could make the pages in the book where they conduct their research that they then turn into a presentation or a poster etc.
